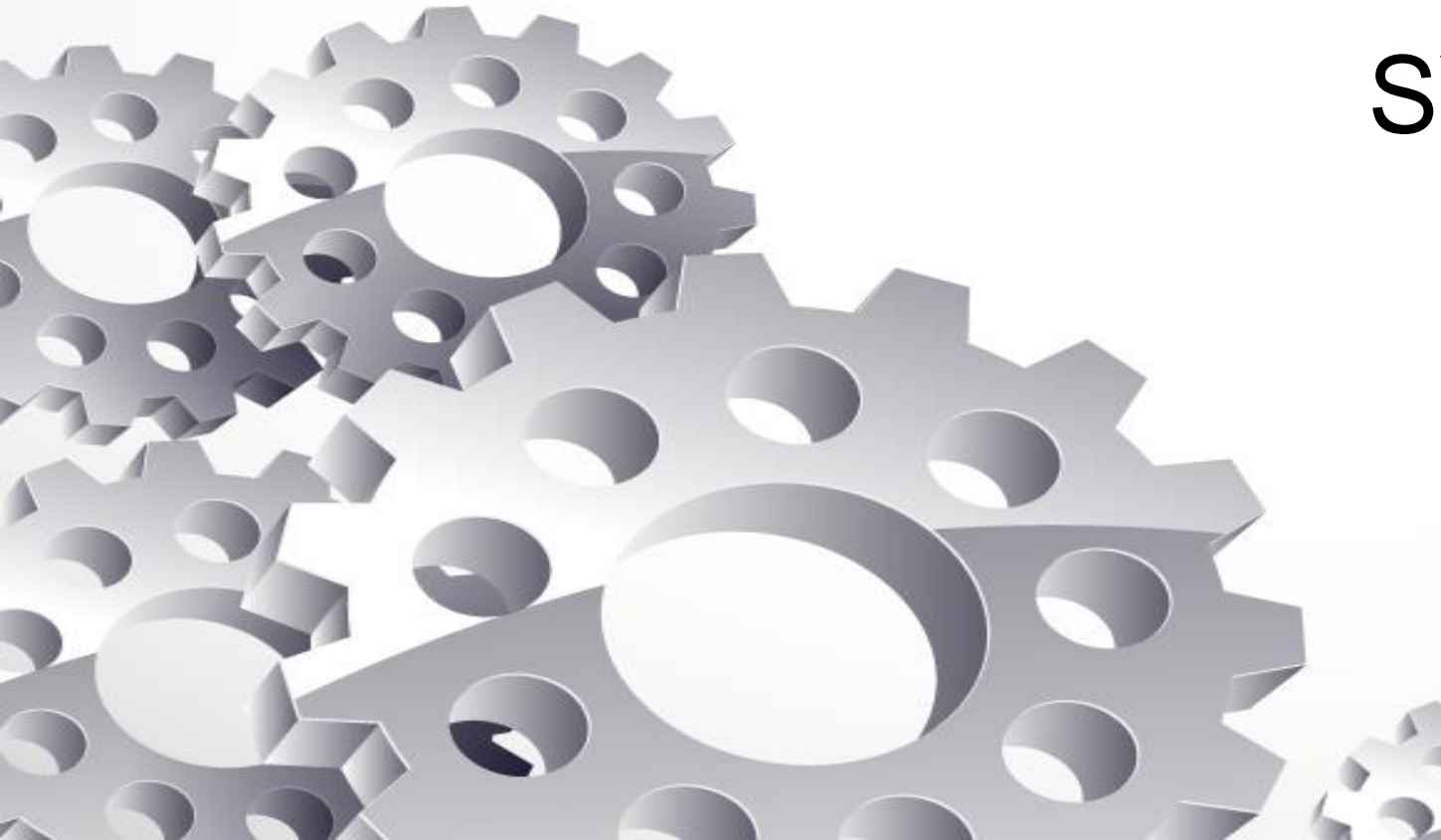

Components of Periodic Assessment



A. General and Professional

- Major Written Exams
(prelims, midterms, semi-finals, finals) - 40%
 - Written Output
(research report/projects/portfolio) - 30%
 - Progressive Assessment
(quiz, reporting, role play, homework, others) - 30%
- Total: 100%

B. Pure Laboratory Subjects

- Major Written Exams
(prelims, midterms, semi-finals, finals) - 20%
 - Practical Assessment - 60%
 - Progressive Assessment
(quiz, reporting, role play, homework, others) - 20%
- Total: 100%

C. Subjects with Laboratory

- Major Written Exams
(prelims, midterms, semi-finals, finals) - 35%
 - Practical Assessment - 35%
 - Progressive Assessment
(quiz, reporting, role play, homework, others) - 30%
- Total 100%
